# Road Closure Update

## Southbound I-710 Fwy To WB Ocean Blvd Connector Ramp

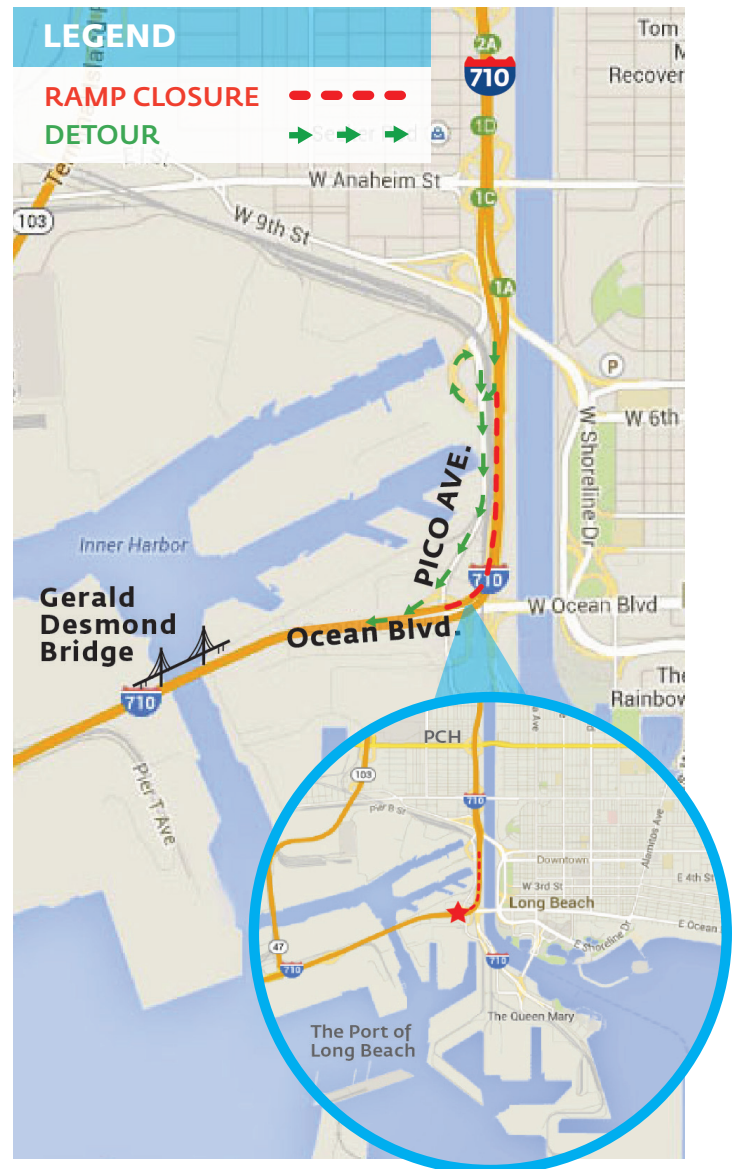
*Start date: 10 a.m. May 10, 2014*

*Duration: 30 Months\**

**Closure:** The connector ramp from the southbound I-710 freeway to westbound Ocean Boulevard will be closed permanently May 10, 2014. The ramp will be demolished as part of the Gerald Desmond Bridge Replacement Project. A new ramp is expected to be completed in about two and a half years.

**Detour:** Traffic traveling from southbound I-710 and heading to Terminal Island and beyond (Port of Long Beach, San Pedro) will be diverted briefly onto surface streets. Motorists will take the Pico Avenue off-ramp (Piers B, C, D, E) and remain in the right lane to reach southbound Pico Avenue. Continue south on Pico for approximately one-half mile to the on-ramp for westbound Ocean Boulevard and the existing Gerald Desmond Bridge to reach Terminal Island and other westbound destinations (on-ramp indicating "Piers S T/Terminal Island"). Detour signs will be posted.
